Summer is the season for picnic lunches and family fun! It is important to keep in mind food safety during the summer months.

Store

- Don't keep food at room temperature for more than one hour on hot summer days
- Keep perishable foods cold in a cooler filled with ice packs
- Keep the cooler out of direct sunlight and avoid opening it too often
- Marinate meat in the refrigerator or in a cooler filled with ice--not on the counter.

<u>Cook</u>

- Bacteria are killed by heat. Raw meat, poultry, and seafood must be cooked to a <u>safe internal</u> <u>temperature</u> to eliminate harmful bacteria. Check the temperature of meat that you are cooking on the barbecue by taking it off the grill and placing it on a clean plate.
- Inset the digital food thermometer through the thickest part or piece of meat.
 - For hamburgers, insert the digital food thermometer through the side of the patty, all the way to the middle. Make sure to check each patty.
 - Always clean your digital food thermometer in warm, soapy water between temperature readings to avoid cross-contamination.
